
Points

Incontinence Management

- → Increase incontinence management during new illnesses, such as diarrhea, urinary infection, flu and colds
- Consider leaving resident "open to air" (no briefs) while in bed
- Monitor perineal and buttock areas with each care opportunity for redness, rash or odor

DON'T









Toilet frequently to avoid incontinence








Use gentle soap or skin cleanser







Apply topical barrier to protect skin with EVERY perineal care



Use plastic incontinence pads on low air loss beds
