

Who Stays Well After Direct Exposure to COVID-19?



Vaccinated = **91%** effective (9 people out of 100 get sick)



Unvaccinated = **7%** effective (93 people out of 100 get sick)



Who Gets COVID-19?

Each person represents 100 cases in a population of 200,000

Who Dies of COVID-19?

Each person represents 1 death in a population of 200,000
