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### Goals

- 1. Develop model policies in accordance with state regulations/requirements that reflect current best practices for infection control and prevention in adult day settings.
- 2. Provide model infection control policies that can be easily adapted throughout adult day centers (ADCs) in Virginia.
- 3. Support implementation of updated infection prevention policies.



### What Does Success Look Like?

- Greater consistency in infection prevention and control policies of Virginia ADCs.
- Increased capacity to prevent and control infections.
- Preparedness to respond quickly and appropriately to future infectious disease threats.
- Decreased risk of participants, employees, family members and service providers getting an ADC-acquired infection and infecting others.



## Steps to Success

- 1. Review and Synthesis of Existing Information
  - Summarize current ADC infection prevention needs and policies
  - Conduct environmental scan and literature review
  - Review of Adult Day Care Infection Prevention Assessment Feedback
- 2. Policy Development
  - Establish policy development workgroup
  - Provide draft policies for review and create final policies
- 3. Implementation Support
  - Provide resources for policy implementation and sustainment
  - Provide opportunities for peer-to-peer learning
