



Prevent Spread

- Transmission-Based Precautions
- Address exposed residents
- Personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Sick leave policies

Testing

- Suspected pathogen
- Known exposure
- Results dictate next steps
- Consider minimally COVID-19, influenza and RSV





Respond



Treatment and Prophylaxis

- Influenza antiviral and prophylaxis
- COVID-19 treatment asap
- RSV symptomatic relief

Investigate

- Surveillance
- Department heads validate prevention methods
- Cleaning and disinfection
- Ventilation
- Early identification of symptomatic individuals and exposed



Moving through the stages:

- Break the ice
- Define purpose and goals
- Establish ground rules
- Redefinition of goals, roles and ground rules
- Task-related and conflict-management skills
- Use members' strengths
- Promote collaboration
- Advocate for the team
- Refocus behaviors
